- Action happening now
- Temporary action
- “these days”, “at present”, “now”

I am studying these days.
We are waiting for the bus.

Common Mistake:

-  I am study.
 -  I am studying.

B. Present Perfect

Structure:

Subject + has/have + V₃

Use:

- Since + point of time
- For + period of time

Example:

I have lived here since 1958.

C. Present Perfect Continuous

Structure:

Subject + has/have been + V₁+ing

Use:

“for five minutes”, “since morning”

Example:

I have been waiting for five minutes.

🎯 Board Trick:
Time given + still continuing = Perfect Continuous

🔥 D. Past Simple

Used after "had + V3" clause

We went for a walk after the rain had stopped.

🔥 E. Future Continuous

Structure: will be + V₁+ing

It will be raining when you reach home.
